I've been very intentional about providing estimates up until now.

Again, the number of provisional ballots and conditional provisional ballots wasn't adding up to your Day After Election Receipt, but we've started entering them to see exactly what we have. We were seeing: 1,615 provisionals in our system + 650 not in our system = 2265

On your receipt, the conditionals were separated, but if we add the conditional provisionals 2265 + 70= 2335 that gets us closer to the original number listed on your receipt.

However, I've been using the numbers from your receipt for reporting purposes which was 2460 Provisionals and 70 Conditional Provisionals.

Provisionals (2460) + Conditional Provisionals (70)	2530
Problem Ballots	460
Awaiting Turnover	197
Total Ballots in Recorder's Possession	3187

I can not give a better estimate until we've finished first checking all the provisionals.

My low estimate is: 2922 My high estimate is: 3187



Provisional Ballots: Approximately 2,400

We've 1st checked approximately half and started to second check them. We will begin preparing a batch to send over to Elections soon.

Provisional Ballots must be completed by Friday, November 18th.

Conditional Provisional: Approximately 70, nearly all completed. Must be completed by Wednesday, November 16 at 5pm.

Problem Ballots: Approximate remaining: 500

We will plan to do another small turnover on Thursday Morning, after we have passed the Conditional Provisional and Problem Ballot Deadline.
