

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### Constance,

As we've begun processing the Provisional Ballots we're seeing operator errors that we need to make a decision on how to handle. We're seeing that Poll Workers issued ballots for a voter's previous address, instead of their new address, which puts them in the wrong precinct. This is not the voter's error, but it would make their vote ineligible.

This was an issue in the Primary Election as well and we decided to submit them as "Duplication Required" and the races they were eligible to vote in were accepted.

Are we okay to move forward with this process on our end, or are we wholly discarding ballots based on Poll Worker Error?

Please let me know how you'd like us to proceed. We sent our ballot processers home for the weekend and this changes the programing, so we needed time to make adjustments. We don't yet know how many Provisional Ballots fall under this issue, we'll have a better sense of that once we go through more. We have seen a few sites where they did everything correctly and we've been able to accept those.

We will be providing our Provisional Ballot Team with instructions at 8am on Monday. Please let us know	so
that we can give our team the correct training.
