Dear Chairman Steil:

We write to respectfully request funds from the reserve fund to continue carrying out the important work of the Committee on the Judiciary and the Select Subcommittee on the Weaponization of the Federal Government in the 118th Congress.

To continue the Committee's and the Select Subcommittee's important work going forward, we respectfully request \$4.5 million in funding from the reserve fund for the second session of the 118th Congress. We also request an additional 15 staff slots for the remainder of the 118th Congress. This additional funding and staff slots will support the operations of the Committee and Select Subcommittee and allow us to hire additional experienced personnel to continue our aggressive oversight and important policy work. Consistent with the practices of the House, the additional funds and staff slots will be split two-thirds for the majority and one-third for the minority.

We are always mindful that we do our work on behalf of the American people, which is why our initial funding request in February 2023 requested the ability to draw from the reserve fund at the appropriate time. As we noted then, and as we continue to believe, we sought this arrangement to allow the Committee and Select Subcommittee to carry out our work effectively and in the most fiscally responsible manner. If we have additional needs in the future, we will make a request for additional funds from the reserve fund at that time.


