eturn your voted ballot in one of the following ways:

By Mail

ive your Ballot Return Envelope to your local postal carrier, or deposit it in any United States ostal Service (USPS) mailbox or at any U.S. post office.

IMPORTANT: Mailed ballots must be postmarked by Election Day (Tuesday, ovember 5) and received at the Board of Elections (BOE) no later than the 10th day after ection Day. We recommend that you vote and mail your ballot as soon as possible to ike sure it arrives on time.

- In any 24-hour secure BOE Mail Ballot Drop Box (beginning Friday, October 11) E has placed 55 secure Mail Ballot Drop Boxes throughout the District of Columbia. You can osit your voted ballot at any time until 8:00 pm on Election Day (Tuesday, November 5). staff will collect ballots daily.
- At any Vote Center (open during early voting and on Election Day) Vote Centers will be open from Monday, October 28 through Sunday, November 3 between the of 8:30 am and 7:00 pm, and Election Day Vote Centers will be open on Tuesday, November 5 en the hours of 7:00 am and 8:00 pm.
